

## Forgiveness Prayer

**Example:** Father in the name of Jesus, I forgive my **Dad** for causing me to feel **inadequate** by taking the hammer out of my hand and not allowing me to finish hammering the nail.

Thank you for healing my damaged emotions, I desire to be changed by Your spirit into the person of God You have created me to be. In Jesus name, Amen.

### **\*Rationalization - minimizing, making excuses for, or intellectualizing feelings about the incident**

And Jesus called a **little child** unto him, and set him in the midst of them, And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as **little children**, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
